pH Balance

STEP ONE: Add pH Up or pH Down as required to balance spa water in 7.2 to 7.8 range. Check with test strips or a test kit.

STEP TWO: If required, add Total Alkalinity Increaser to bring your spa water within the correct range of 80 to 120. Check with test strips or a test kit.

STEP THREE: To a freshly-filled spa, add (one quart) 32 fluid ounces of this product per 275 to 500 gallons while the spa water is circulating. After addition of this product, pH will be maintained in the proper range.

Add this product only at the time of a fresh-water fill. It will normally last from one to five months depending on the number of bathers and the type of sanitizer used. Empty and refill your spa at least every 16 weeks, or earlier if it becomes difficult to keep the water clear after normal chlorinating or brominating.

Always check your pH reading regularly. If there are unusual local water situations, it may be necessary to add pH UP or pH Down. However, the amount of pH Up or pH Down required will be much lower when this product is used.

In hard water areas, if clouding occurs when this product is added, a good stain and scale preventer should be added. Consult your local dealer. Stain and scale preventer is recommended at every fresh fill; subsequent doses may be required on a weekly basis to maintain water clarity.
